Whether it's a chosen hairstyle, color of tights, or makeup options, we encourage each 3D dancer to do what makes them feel their best and shine their brightest!

HAIRSTYLES FOR DANCERS

3D does not require a specific hairstyle for recital. Dancers should choose a hairstyle that is neat and and applicable to dancing. Hair should be pulled away from face and should be easily maintained. Choose one hairstyle that will work appropriately with the sytle of dances they are cast.

MAKEUP FOR DANCERS

The strong stage lighting can easily wash out dancers. In order to see their features best, it is recommended that they wear makeup. Stage Makeup usually includes foundation, blush, mascara, eye shadow and a red/pink lipstick. Try to match your dancers skin tone as best possible with foundation and powder. Please refrain from bold colors, face paint, and body glitter.

The classes listed below were sent emails with links for required accessories. The info is also included in the costume graphic sticker that was attached to their costumes at distribution and included in this Recital LookBook.

Please double check your emails if you have not seen it so you can have your dancer's required accessories here by 3D Pic Week.

- Bobby socks are required for all preschool classes.
- Keds Original Leather White Lace-Ups are the required shoe for all classes except Little Shop of Horrors & Sweet Charity

ALTERATIONS

It's very common for recital costumes to need alterations.

It's important to understand that each costume only comes in 4-7 sizes so making minor adjustments such as hemming pantlengths, tacking straps, adding fabric to make a costume more comfortable for the dancer, and more scenarios are often necessary adjustments. The 3D Costume Fee does not cover any alterations. Provided below is our recommened seamstress that is paid directly.

Maintenance & Care

-always hang costumes with a tutu upside down from the bottom of the leotard

 try on costume upon receiving and then immediately hang




